
# How to Eat Fried Worms – Thomas Rockwell




# The Mouse and the Motorcycle - Beverly Cleary

importance of words, numbers, ideas, creativity, and enthusiasm for life. **L, S** 


# Who Were the Tuskegee Airmen? - Sherri L. Smith

# 4th Grade Battle: Wednesday, April 10, 2024 at 7:00 PM Edgeworth Elementary School

#### WHAT IS THE BATTLE OF THE BOOKS?

The Battle of the Books is a program designed to encourage reading and to give recognition to those who like to read. Team members read from a list of books selected by the Children's Department of the Sewickley Public Library, and compete with other teams by answering questions based on the books. We also have a team poster contest and we encourage teams to dress up in themed costumes for the evening of the Battle. The poster contest is the evening of the battle. Posters are due to the library by March 6.

#### WHO MAY PARTICIPATE?

Fourth grade students should have a LIBRARY CARD IN ALLEGHENY COUNTY to be eligible to participate in the Battle of the Books. Participants should organize their own teams and submit a registration form on the library website. Teams may be made up from different schools and neighbors. Each team should consist of four to five members, an adult team manager and a team name. All five team members will participate in the competition. A student may only be on one team.

## WHAT IS THE PROCEDURE FOR THE "BATTLE"?

Teams participating in the "BATTLE" will meet at 6:45 PM at Edgeworth Elementary on Wednesday, April 10, 2024. Each team will be seated in a circle. After the moderator reads a question, each team will have 30 seconds to confer and decide upon the answer to the question. The team captain will write the answer on the paper provided. Answers must be complete and specific. 4 points are awarded for the correct response and 1 point is given if the team writes the author's last name; spelling counts. Each team will have the ability to challenge 1 question and/or answer.

#### WHAT DOES A TEAM MANAGER DO?

The adult team manager may be a parent, teacher, relative or anyone over the age of 18 who will serve as the contact person between the team and the Sewickley Public Library. The team manager is responsible for filling out and returning the registration form to the library, keeping the team members motivated, and arranging team transportation to and from the site of the Battle of the Books Tournament. Team managers will serve as assistants during the tournament.
